



GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF NOMINEES

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Nominees for President must have served as a District President or a member of the LWML Executive Committee (Bylaws, Article VII, Section 2c).

Nominees for officers other than President must be members of the LWML and have served on an LWML District Board of Directors (Bylaws, Article VII, Section 2b.).

All nominees must:

- be familiar with:
 - the LWML, its Mission Statement and Primary Targets,
 - LWML Bylaws and organizational structure, and
 - LWML Committees and their purpose statements.
- have experience in the area in which they will be asked to serve.

GIFTS, SKILLS AND OTHER IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

An organized person who can handle several responsibilities simultaneously.

A dependable person who meets deadlines.

A woman with writing skills and the ability to speak to large and small groups.

A woman with the health and stamina to work under pressure for long periods of time and stand the rigors of travel.

A family situation which allows for extended absences from home without hardship to the family.
