



## December 2007 Story Lutheran Bible Translators' Transportation

There are more than 2,000 ethnic groups that still do not have God's Word in their own language! The mission of Lutheran Bible Translators (LBT) is to help bring people to faith in Jesus Christ by making the Word of God available to those who do not yet have it in the language of their hearts. LBT has 89 missionaries stationed in 19 countries on five continents. These missionaries often live in areas reached only by passing through rugged terrain or where transportation services are not readily available; some must cross desert regions. They may be based in situations where a dependable vehicle is needed in an emergency situation. Safe and reliable vehicles are an absolute necessity.

With the world situation becoming increasingly uncertain and complex, it is important that LBT missionaries have dependable transportation to meet the needs of the areas where they serve. The spiritual as well as the physical well-being of each missionary is a high priority for LBT. LWML has a long-standing relationship with LBT reflecting our shared goal of ministry to the people of the world. This mission grant will purchase two vehicles.
