



KFUO Radio is home to AM 850 and CLASSIC99/ KFUEO FM and has more than 80 years of rich history with the achievement of being the longest continuously running broadcast facility (television or radio) in the United States.

As the only classical music station in the St. Louis region, KFUEO FM delivers excellent music to listeners and serves the community as the primary mouthpiece for St. Louis' arts and cultural institutions, choral music, and Christian outreach through sacred music.

KFUO Radio is owned and operated by The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. The station falls under the supervision of the Board for Communication Services while the KFUEO Radio Committee provides management and oversight. It made its beginning in 1924 when radio was little more than a hobby.

Through the power of Internet streaming and podcasting, KFUEO AM 850 reaches people around the world. The www.kfuo.org Web site offers a wide array of audio resources including worship services and Bible studies. Audio vignettes from nationally renowned speakers like Dr. Mary Manz Simon and Rev.
