Leader: *In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. (The sign of the cross may be made)*

All: Amen.

Leader: *Almighty God, we thank you for your love and endless blessings. Through reading and studying Your Word, we pray that Your Holy Spirit will empower us, especially the blind children in Africa, to see the light.*

All: Amen.

Reader 1: I will lead the blind by ways they have not known, along unfamiliar paths I will guide them; I will turn the darkness into light before them and make the rough places smooth. These are the things I will do; I will not forsake them. (Isaiah 42:16)

Reader 2: For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth). (Ephesians 5:8-9)

Reader 3: When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” (John 8:12)

Leader: *Almighty and everlasting God, we thank You for Your Word. We pray that You will bless the mission and work of the Lutheran Braille Workers by providing English Braille Bibles for the blind children in Africa. We pray in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*
