MISSION GRANT STORY

LUTHERAN BRAILLE WORKERS ENGLISH BRAILLE BIBLES

Africa - \$100,000

In the United States, Lutheran Braille Workers is the only faith-based organization that produces Braille Bibles for the continent of Africa.

There are seven million blind people in Africa, most of them Muslims or of tribal religions. Many of the blind people do not know Jesus as Savior and do not have a way to receive a Bible except through Lutheran Braille Workers.

Recently, representatives of Lutheran Braille Workers attending a conference in Africa met a young boy named Bobo who is blind. The representatives promised Bobo that on the last day of the conference, he would be given the Gospel of Luke in English Braille. Among the large crowd that last day, LBW representatives found him and gave him the Gospel. They witnessed such joy and exuberance as the boy hugged his treasure, jumping up and down. Bobo gave us an example of the joy one feels in receiving God's Word!

Lutheran Braille Workers currently has orders for 86,025 volumes of either the International Children's Bible (Grade 1 in English Braille) or the New International Version Bible (Grade 2 in English Braille) for Africa. More than 5,000 Lutheran Braille Worker volunteers produce the Bibles, but they remain dependent on gifts and grants to offer them to blind people free upon request.

This LWML grant will provide funds to produce 13,700 English Braille Bibles for the students in schools in Africa, 90% of whom are Muslim. Our LWML prayers attend this project, trusting that blind people in Africa will come to faith through God's Word and become ablaze in winning souls for Christ.
