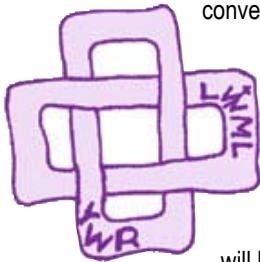


Mites Over the Top!
