The LWML has adopted a \$1.825 million mission goal for the 2009-11 biennium, the largest mite goal in the LWML's 67-year history. This is an increase of \$125,000 over the previous goal. Praise God for blessing the LWML with such mission-minded women! We will fund a record of 19 mission grants:
