### LWML Prayer Service 2010 — “Beautiful Feet”

“Beautiful Feet” is the theme of the 2010 LWML Prayer Service. It is based on one of the 2009 Portland LWML Convention theme verses, Isaiah 52:7: *How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, “Your God reigns!”*

The service, authored by Rev. Philip Esala, encourages us to spend time in prayer and to look for opportunities to share the Good News of Jesus with people in our communities in everyday situations, proclaiming the peace only He provides as He brings us salvation. Rev. Esala serves as senior pastor of Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Kettering, Ohio.
