### Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology — Deaconess Training **\$100,000**

In many immigrant communities, cultural barriers hinder men from direct contact with women. This presents difficulties for mission and evangelism, and it raises the importance of women to reach out with the love of Jesus to immigrant communities.

The Ethnic Immigrant Institute of Theology and the Hispanic Institute of Theology are working to develop a deaconess track to train women for mission



and ministry through Concordia Seminary, St. Louis.

There are more than 200 Asian ministries, 100 African immigrant ministries, and more than 150 Hispanic missions in the LCMS.

A grant of \$100,000 provides for this deaconess training.
