



**Exodus 2:6 Project: Spiritual Care in Disasters – Texas, Louisiana, Oklahoma**  
**\$50,000**

Lutheran Social Services of the South and its affiliated ministry, Lutheran Social Services Disaster Response, provide disaster response, recovery, and crucial spiritual care to youth and children in the midst of trauma when no other resources exist.

A grant of \$50,000 to Lutheran Social Services of the South helps to fund expenses of volunteers and provide Christian materials and activities for children negatively affected by natural or other disasters.



**Grace Place for LCMS International Missionaries**  
**\$75,000**

Grace Place works in harmony with LCMS World Mission, Commission on Ministerial Growth and Support, Congregational Health Ministries (World Relief and Human Care), Concordia Plan Services, and other entities of Synod to focus on keeping church workers healthy: physically, emotionally, relationally, fiscally, and spiritually.

A grant of \$75,000 provides underwriting for three LCMS International Missionary Grace Place events in Asia (2012), Eurasia (2013), and Latin America (2014) to serve all LCMS missionaries in those regions.

**Children’s Developmental Disabilities Group Home and Rehabilitation Center — Dominican Republic**  
**\$100,000**

Good Shepherd Lutheran Homes in the Dominican Republic shares the Gospel of Jesus Christ with people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families. These individuals currently receive no educational or recreational opportunities, no rehabilitative care, no spiritual care, or are abandoned; the Dominican government provides no support or training for them and their parents.

A grant of \$100,000 allows Good Shepherd Lutheran Homes in the Dominican Republic to construct a group home and rehabilitation center and provide for staffing.
